

Constitutional Candidate's

Affidavit of Statement

I, _____, (First, Middle, Last Name- upper & lower-case style), hereby publicly execute this Affidavit of my own free will, without reservation, coercion, or duress;

If I am elected as a representative of the People, I firmly believe that I must, and hereby demonstrate by this Affidavit, that I **shall**, abide by my oath to the United States, in the performance of my official duties; thus, upholding both the United States and The State of Arizona Constitutions. All laws made pursuant thereto, must align with and not violate the Constitutions. I will only act within the lawful scope of my Constitutionally delegated authority, and faithfully uphold the Public Trust;

Those who serve in governments in this nation have gone astray and have forsaken the basic principles upon which the United States was founded. If elected, I will reestablish the United States original principles, as set forth in our founding documents, *The Declaration of Independence and the Constitution of the United States, circa 1787, as amended with the Bill of Rights in 1791*. To that end, I hereby attest that I will reaffirm the referenced Constitution, as the Supreme Law of the Land, pursuant to Article VI of that document, and The State of Arizona Constitution as the governing Law of Arizona, and I will uphold all averments and affirmations made herein;

I hereby swear or affirm that, pursuant to my oath and to this Affidavit, I will never introduce, draft, support or vote for any form of legislation that opposes or contradicts the United States and The State of Arizona Constitutions, in any way, whatsoever, or opposes Rights secured therein to the People. I shall support all legislation necessary to carry into effect provisions of the United States Constitution, United States Bill of Rights, The State of Arizona Constitution, and The State of Arizona Declaration of Rights;

I hereby make these statements in this publicly executed Affidavit to the People of the state of Arizona to demonstrate that, if I am elected, I consent to be governed by the Constitutions. I will uphold the Constitutions, and all rights within the United States Bill of Rights and the Arizona Declaration of Rights. I will faithfully serve the best interests of the People of the state of Arizona.

The initial oath of office was memorialized by the original Congress in 1789. Upon entering office, I shall affirm and adhere to the following *U.S. Statute 1 Chapter 1*. See below:

"The oath or affirmation required by the sixth Article of the Constitution of the United States, shall be administered in the form following, to wit:

"I, A.B. do solemnly swear or affirm (as the case may be) that I will support the Constitution of the United States." *U.S. Statute 1 Chapter 1*.
